

# Kellands Primary School Streets Project

## What is a 'School Streets Project'?

This project aims to consider the value and benefit of introducing **part-time road closures** around school gates. The objective is to reduce the number of vehicles in the location where pupils are entering and exiting the school, to help create a safer and cleaner environment at the school gate.

Please be mindful of where you park and consider parking a little further away from the school. This map shows the approximate walking time from different parking locations.

## What are the benefits of this project?

- 1** Reduction in traffic at the point where all children are going in and out of the school, providing safer places to cross and better visibility for young people.
- 2** Fewer vehicles will encourage more families to travel actively to school, for example, walking, cycling, scooting or 'park and stride', which will lead to mental and physical health benefits.
- 3** Poor air quality can exist even in rural areas at peak congested times and removing traffic will help improve air quality for young people.
