

Cycle CoN Nect

Cycle CoNNect is a new bike hire service in Northampton, with 50 bikes available to hire 24 hours a day. The scheme is free to join and means you can rent a bike for £1 per hour up to a maximum charge of £5 for a whole day. Go to

www.cvcleconnect.co.uk and register your details. On your first visit you will be asked to buy an initial £3 credit and will then get a membership number and unique PIN code. Keep these with you when you go to your chosen bike hub and enter them into the console as instructed. Also make a note of the customer

services number which you may need if you need to lock the bike with the combination cable at any of the hubs. Choose a bike and away you go. You will be able to see the live map of bike hubs on the website to check availability and locations.

University Quick and Quiet Cycle Routes

Cycling is a guick, easy, cheap and healthy way of travelling between the University of Northampton Park and Avenue campuses. There are two signed routes linking the sites:

QUICK the 'Quick' route which takes a direct line along Eastern Avenue North, or

QUIET the 'Quiet' route which takes a more leisurely path through the lovely parkland of Bradlaugh Fields.

At an average speed it should take approximately 12 to 20 minutes to cycle between the two campuses depending on the route chosen.


