

By Bus (E)

St Helier is served by several bus routes including the 151 between Wallington and Worcester Park, the 157 between Crystal Palace and Morden, the S1 between Mitcham and Banstead and the S4 from Roundshaw towards St Helier Station. All of these buses stop directly outside the hospital. There are additional bus routes which run from Rose Hill (about a five minute walk).

Please see the map overleaf to find your nearest bus route and frequency.

By Train 🗐

St Helier has several train stations nearby and they are all linked by one or more of the local bus routes. Stations include: Sutton Common (about 1km), St Helier (about 1.5km) and Carshalton (about 1.7km).

Trains from St Helier and Sutton Common are on the line which runs between Sutton and Wimbledon, with direct links to Blackfriars and Kings Cross. Trains from Carshalton are on the line that runs between Sutton and Mitcham, with direct links to London Bridge, Victoria, Epsom, Horsham and Dorking. The closest London Underground station is Morden (about 2.5km) which links to the Northern Line. The closest Tramlink station is Mitcham Junction (about 2.2km).

All walking routes to the site are well maintained and well lit. Walking regularly, like other physical exercise, can bring about major health benefits such as reducing coronary heart disease and obesity. As well as being a healthy option, it is also friendly to the environment.

St Helier is about a 30 minute walk from Carshalton and a 40 minute walk from Sutton. Try replacing one or more of your journeys each week with a walk to work.

St Helier has an extensive cycle network serving the hospital. Information about cycling in London, and a cycle journey planner, can be found at www.tfl.gov.uk/cycles. Transport for London (TfL) Cycling Guides 10 and 12 provide detailed cycling routes for the area and copies of the guides are available from TfL.

Cycle parking is available on the site, some of which is reserved for staff. For access to the secure cycling parking facilities on the site contact the security team on ext 721 2335.

The Trust operates a cycle to work scheme (called Cyclescheme). The scheme allows employees to buy a bicycle and safety equipment through a salary sacrifice arrangement. This means you can save up to 40% on the cost of a new bicycle and equipment. Further details of the scheme can be accessed through the Trust intranet, Insight (under the travel section).

Shuttle bus

The Trust runs an inter-site shuttle bus between St Helier Hospital, Sutton Hospital and Epsom Hospital. This service operates from 7am to 6pm with the following timetable:

Workplace travel plan
