Catching the bus in High Wycombe couldn't be easier. All routes call at the Bus Station in the town centre within Eden Shopping Centre, while many call at the Railway Station and Oxford Street too. Areas within High Wycombe town are served by the Rainbow Routes network www.rainbowroutes.co.uk This is a colour coded network of regular bus services running between the town's estates and the town centre.


