



## By Bus

Orpington High Street is served by a number of bus services to destinations including Bromley, Catford, Lewisham, Sidcup and Bexleyheath. A full list of services and a map can be found on the reverse. Nearest bus stops to the College are The Walnuts Centre on Orpington High Street and also Homefield Rise.

## By Bike

A network of signed cycle routes lead around the outskirts of Orpington Town Centre. Knoll Rise is signed as a recommended cycle route, however with no road markings. Spur Road is also a recommended route and is signed with on-road markings for cyclists. The map on the reverse has the cycle network and its recommended roads shown in orange.

Cycle parking can be found at the rear of the College. Please speak to Reception for further details.

## By Train

Orpington rail station is the closest station to Orpington College and is a 15 minute walk away. High frequency services operate to London Victoria, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross from this station. Other key London stations can also be accessed including Lewisham, Catford and Bromley South. Services from Kent also stop at Orpington including Sevenoaks and Tunbridge Wells.

St Mary Cray rail station is a 45 minute walk or a 10 minute bus journey away. This station provides access to services from London to the Kent Coast including Rochester, Chatham, Ramsgate and Dover. Thameslink services to Farringdon, Kings Cross and Bedford are also accessed at this station.

Cycles can be carried on train services, except during busy weekday peak periods (trains due to arrive in London between 0700 and 0959, and those due to leave London between 1600 and 1859). Only folded cycles can be carried on these services.

## College Travel Code

- Orpington College encourages students, staff and visitors to walk, cycle and use sustainable transport (including car sharing) wherever possible.
- As an Orpington student, when you travel to/from home you carry the good name and reputation of the College with you.
- The same high standards are expected of you when travelling as apply at the College site.
- Courtesy must be shown to fellow passengers, road users, bus and railway staff at all times.
- When travelling, you must have a valid ticket for your journey. Advice on reducing journey costs is available from Student Services.
- Students acting in an anti-social manner whilst travelling will have their Oyster travel concession withdrawn by Transport for London.
- In the interests of safety, travel with other students whenever you can.
- Always leave home early enough to arrive at College in comfortable time for your first lesson of the day.

Journey planning for walkers can be ideal to find the most direct/safest route. Visit [www.walkit.com](http://www.walkit.com) for details.

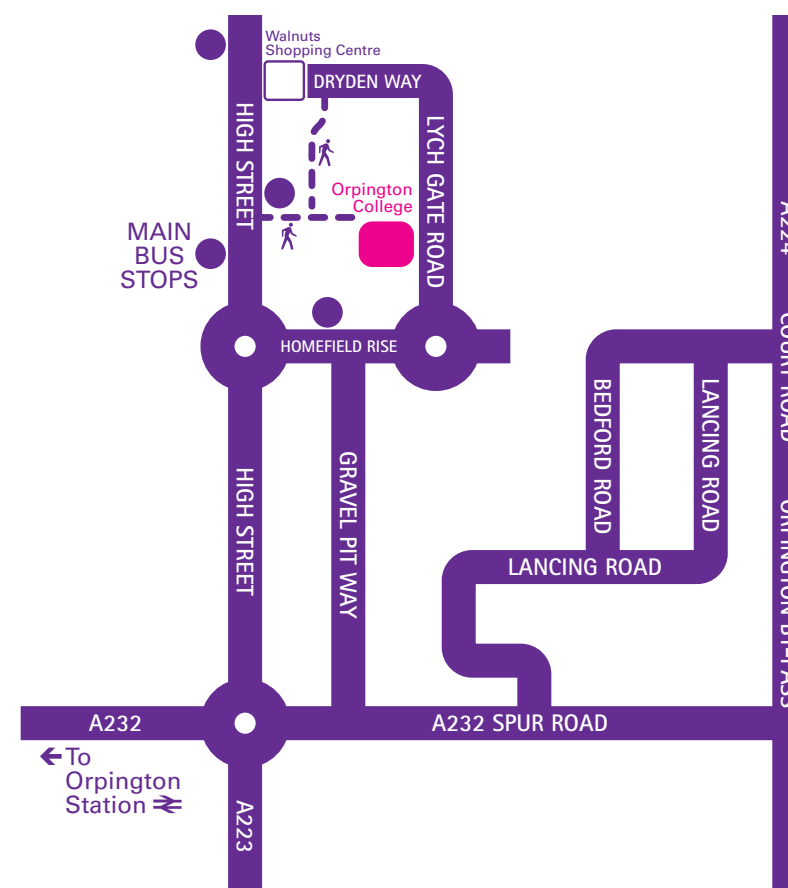
## By Car

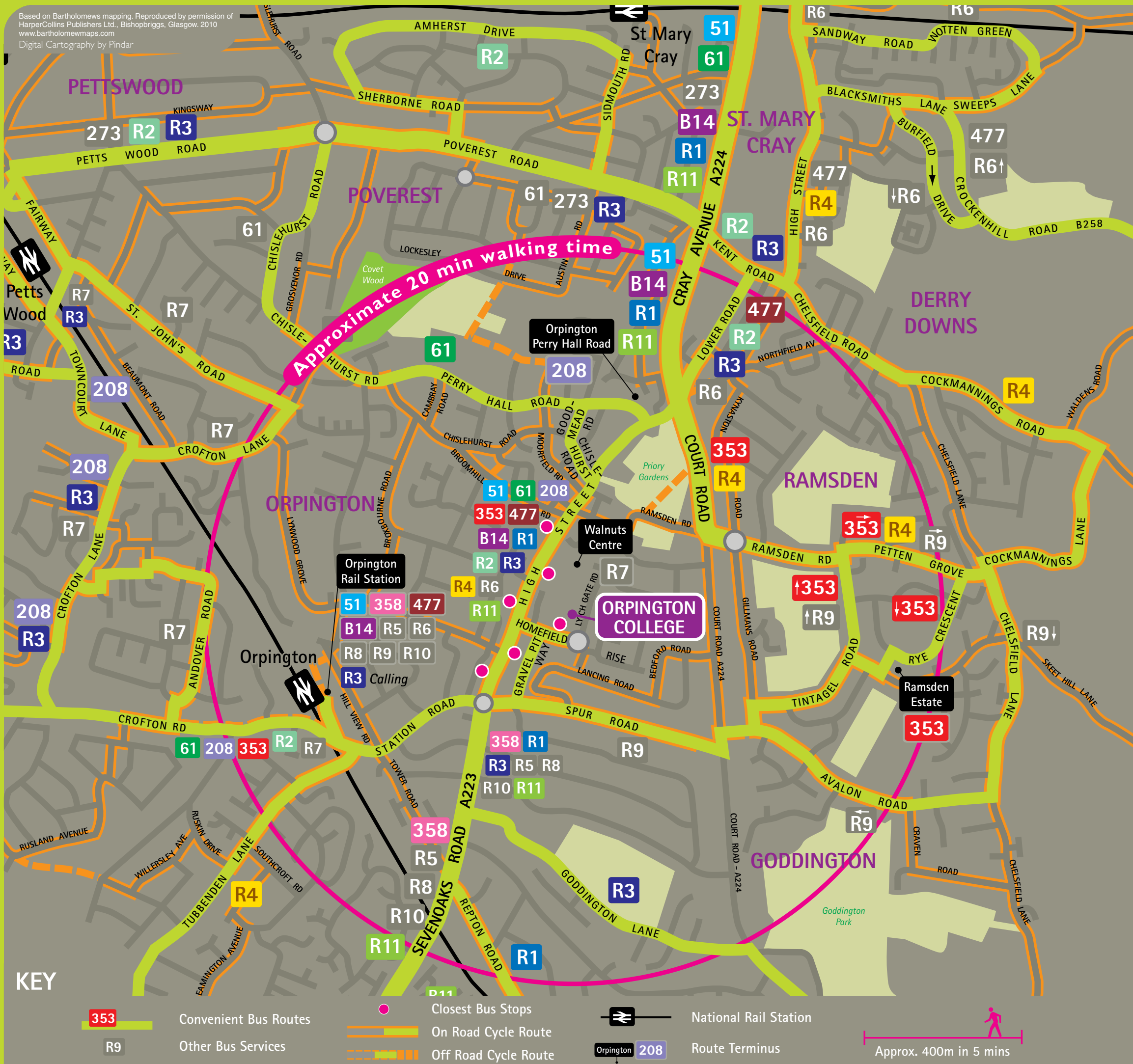
